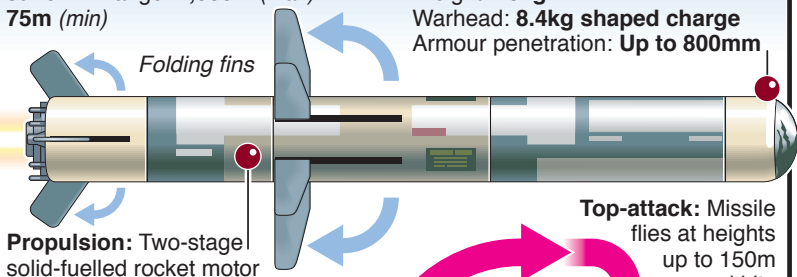


Javelin missile – ideal for urban fighting

The U.S. Marine Corps' newest anti-tank missile automatically guides itself to the target after launch, allowing the gunner to take cover or reload another round. With a choice of "top-attack" or "direct-attack," the weapon system is designed for both battlefield and urban warfare

"Fire-and-forget" FGM-148 Javelin: Range: 2,000m (max)
75m (min)

Length: 1.76 metres
Weight: 28kg
Warhead: 8.4kg shaped charge
Armour penetration: Up to 800mm



Reduced back blast area: Can be fired from inside buildings without risk

Disposable launch tube

Top-attack: Missile flies at heights up to 150m and hits from above to penetrate tank's most vulnerable armour

Direct-attack: Flies beneath 50m to target buildings

Command Launch Unit: Day and infrared night vision sight. Can also be used for battlefield surveillance
