The U.S. Army has unveiled its newest combat brigade and its first new armoured vehicle in two decades. Stryker units can be rapidly deployed to respond to multiple unconventional threats around the globe

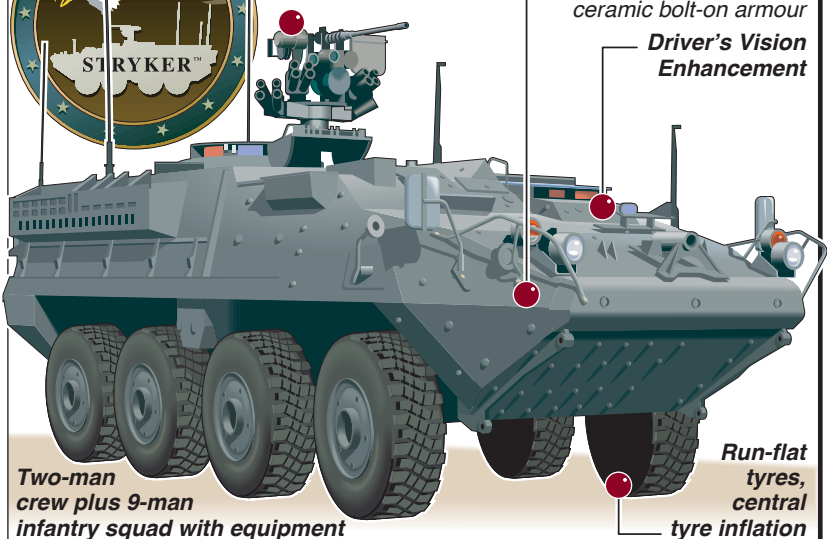
Stryker Infantry Carrier Vehicle

Armour Protection System: Spall liner, ballistic steel structure, RPG protection and ceramic bolt-on armour

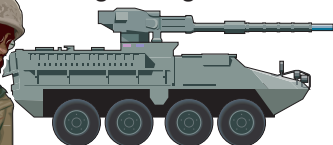
