

# World Court to rule on security barrier

The International Court of Justice in the Hague is to rule on Israel's controversial \$1 billion security barrier following protests by Jordan that it could spark a mass migration of Palestinians across their border

**Seam zone:** Almost 14,000 Palestinians living in restricted military area between **Green line** and security fence

**Qalqilya:** Completely encircled by barrier

**Ariel:** Cabinet is now debating moving route of barrier closer to Green line leaving settlement bloc isolated

**Solid wall:** 8m high, prefabricated, reinforced concrete wall in areas designated high-risk

**Barbed wire pyramid**  
Stacked rolls 2m high

**Ditch 2m deep**  
To prevent vehicle attacks on barrier

Unpaved, foot patrols and IDF vehicles

**Intrusion detection fence:** Electrified, 3m high  
**Security camera**
