

New typhoon threatens Philippines

Typhoon **Nanmadol** is set to become the fourth severe storm to strike the Philippines in two weeks. **Nanmadol** – the 29th typhoon to hit the Western North Pacific Basin this year – is expected to pack winds of 150km/h

1 **Japan, Oct:** Typhoon **Tokage**, record 10th storm of year to hit Japan, kills at least 78 people and causes damage worth \$839 million. **Total deaths in excess of 100**

2 **Taiwan, Oct:** Three killed by Typhoon **Nock-Ten**. Typhoon **Aere** kills over 30 in August, **Mindulle** kills 29 in July

3 **Philippines, Nov:** Tropical storm **Winnie** kills over 400, 100 remain missing. Typhoons **Muifa** and **Merbok** leave 167 people dead or missing
