

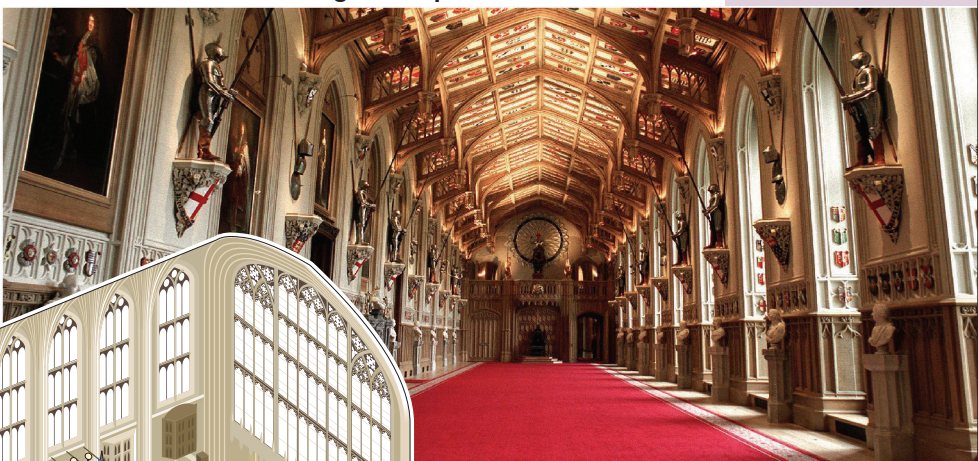


1070: Wooden castle built by **William the Conqueror**. Rebuilt in stone by **Henry II** in 1170s. Castle's present appearance due mainly to alterations by **George IV** in 1820s

WINDSOR CASTLE

Prince Charles is to marry Camilla Parker Bowles at a private civil ceremony at Windsor Guildhall. The Archbishop of Canterbury will then preside over a televised service of prayer and dedication in St George's Chapel at Windsor Castle

Windsor is the largest occupied castle in the world and one of **Queen Elizabeth's** official residences

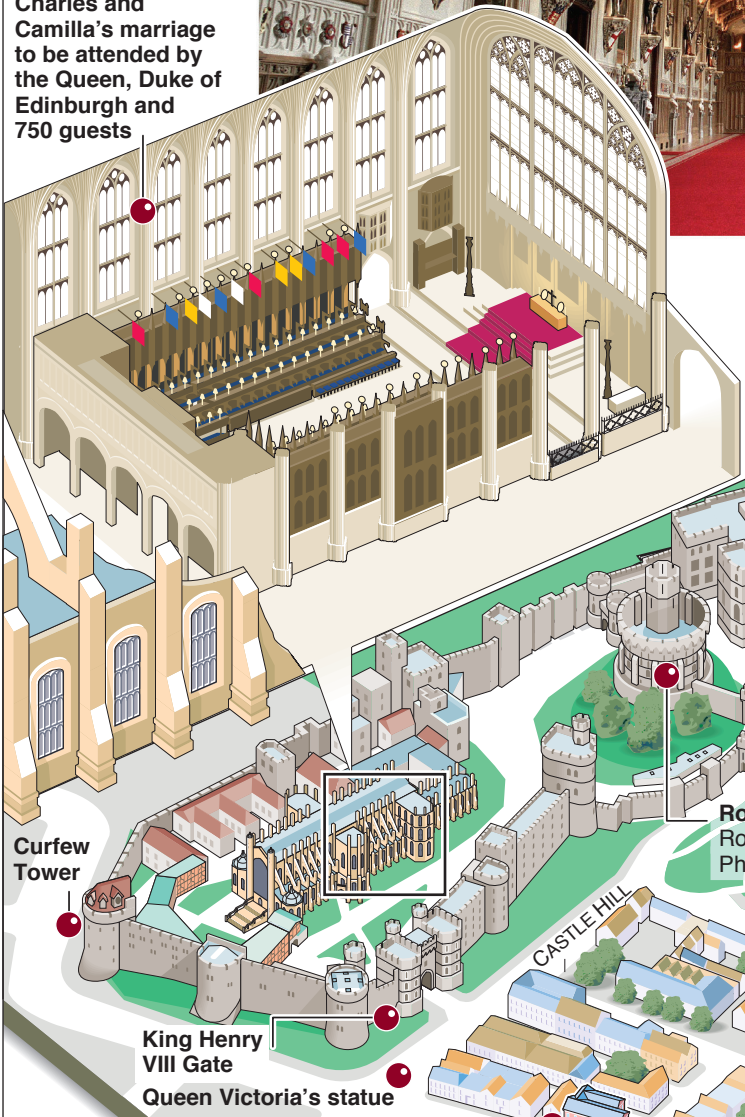


State Apartments: Restored after fire in 1992. Will host Charles and Camilla's reception
