

State of withdrawal from Gaza Strip

The removal of Gaza settlers from their homes is expected to be completed by Tuesday, much faster than initially planned. The removal of 9,000 residents in all 21 settlements in the Gaza Strip and four West Bank enclaves was initially expected to take several weeks
