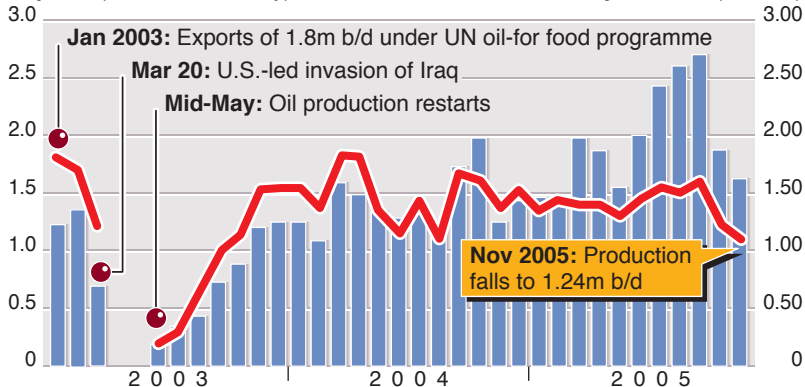


Iraq's oil production declining

Latest figures show Iraq's oil production at its lowest level in a year, with repeated sabotage preventing Baghdad meeting its target of three million barrels a day, a level last seen in 1990. Since May 2003, pipelines carrying Iraqi oil have been attacked by insurgents more than 200 times
