

# Qantas fleet renewal

Australian flag carrier Qantas has placed an order for 65 *Boeing 787 Dreamliner* passenger jets in a multibillion dollar plan to renew its fleet. The order comes on top of a deal to buy 12 new *Airbus A380* superjumbo planes – the world's largest passenger jet – to cope with future growth
