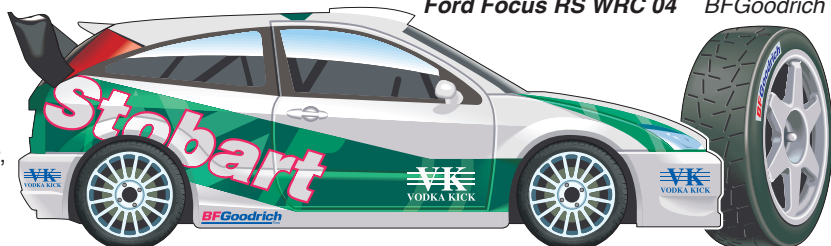


STOBART VK M-SPORT FORD
