Dozens dead in runaway train crash

At least 45 people were killed and nearly 200 injured, half of them children, when a passenger train plunged into a river canyon in southern Montenegro. The disaster – which occured about 10km north of the capital Podgorica – is one of the deadliest European train accidents in 25 years



- Monday, 12:15GMT: Train carrying about 250 people leaves Bijelo Polje, heading for port city of Bar
- 2 14:35GMT: Crew members stop train after leaving Bratonozici station and attempt to fix problem with brakes
- **14:50GMT:** Brakes fail, train starts moving rapidly gaining speed as it veers out of control
- 4 15:00GMT: Train derails emerging from tunnel near Bioce. All four coaches plunge into Moraca canyon
