DEADLIEST ATTACKS DURING CEASEFIRE

1 Feb 25, Tel Aviv: Five Israelis killed and 38 injured in bomb blast outside night club

2 Jul 12, Netanya: Palestinian suicide bomber kills five people near Sharon shopping mall

3 Jul 15, Salfit and Gaza city: Seven Hamas militants killed by Israeli Air Force targeted strikes

4 Aug 24, Tulkarem: Israel kills five Palestinians – alleged militants linked to suicide bombings

5 Oct 26, Hadera: 5 Israelis killed, 30 wounded in suicide bombing in town's market place

6 Oct 27, Gaza: Eight Palestinians – including two members of *Islamic Jihad* – killed in IAF air strike

7 Dec 5, Netanya: Palestinian suicide bomber kills five people and injures dozens in Sharon Mall
