

Real Madrid tops soccer's global rich list

Spanish football giant Real Madrid has toppled Manchester United as the biggest money-spinner in world sport. England's Premier League dominates the top 20, followed by Italy and then Spain, but new broadcast deals in France and Germany are expected to strengthen their revenues
