

Biggest UK robberies



■ **Feb 22, 2006:** Armed gang, posing as police officers, steals up to £40 million from security depot in Tonbridge, 25 miles south of London

■ **Dec 2004:** £26.4m stolen from **Northern Bank** HQ in Belfast. Most of the cash has yet to be recovered

■ **Feb 2002:** Thieves take £3.4m from **British Airways** van at Heathrow Airport

■ **Jul 1987:** Goods worth over £10m stolen from 120 safe deposit boxes at warehouse opposite **Harrods**, London

■ **Nov 1983:** £26m in gold bullion stolen from **Brinks-Mat** high security vault at Heathrow

■ **Aug 1963:** Armed robbers steal £2.6m – equivalent to £40m today – from Glasgow-London mail train in **Great Train Robbery**
