Education: £34bn in new investment in schools over next five years. Recruit 3,000 new science teachers. £500m extra capital investment to close funding gap between public and private sector. All primary schools to receive annual direct payments of £44,000, secondary schools to get £150,000-£365,000, with rises in 2007. Free education to A-Level standard for those up to age 25



**Health:** Budget of at least £1bn per year for Medical Research Council and NHS research under single body. Expansion of research and development tax credit



**Employment:** Doubling of training for low-skilled women, increase working credit, increase minimum wage from Oct to £5.35 per hour



**Housing: £970m** for shared equity to help new homebuyers. Real estate investment trusts to be introduced. Stamp duty exemption threshold raised to £125,000. Inheritance tax threshold to rise from £275,000 to £325,000 over four years. Extra insulation help for 250,000 pensioners and low-income families. £5m for micro-energy generation for initial 25,000 buildings



Law and order: £100m to increase number of community police officers to 16,000. £1m endowment fund for victims of terrorism



**Sport:** £600m for training and facilities for athletes for 2012 Olympics. New *Schools Olympics* each year. Initial funding of £34m for new National Sports Foundation
