

Peru faces runoff

Former army officer Ollanta Humala, a nationalist in the mould of Venezuela's Hugo Chavez, took an early lead in Peru's presidential elections but fell far short of the 50% plus one vote needed for outright victory. The top two finishers will face each other in a runoff on May 7
