


Iran's new missile puts Europe in range

Iran has begun receiving its first batch of BM25 surface-to-surface missiles that put some central European countries within firing range, according to Israeli military intelligence. The missiles, purchased from North Korea, have a range of 2,500km and are capable of carrying nuclear warheads



BM25: Liquid fuel ballistic missile known in North Korea as **Nodong-B** – adapted from Soviet **SSN6** submarine-launched missile

Range: BM25 has longer reach than Iran's existing **Shahab-3** – missile capable of hitting Israel
