**1861:** The American Civil War began when the Confederate Army attacked Fort Sumter in South Carolina

1944: King Victor Emmanuel of Italy announced his intention to abdicate when the Allies entered Rome

**1961:** Soviet cosmonaut Yuri Gargarin became the first man to fly in space

1999: Support for NATO attacks on Serbia wavered after ten civilians were killed when two missiles struck a passenger train crossing a bridge
