1839: The Kingdom of Belgium was formally recognised by all the states of Europe

1906: Nobel Prize-winning French scientist Pierre Curie was run over in a Paris street and killed instantly

1995: A car bomb tore apart a federal building in Oklahoma City, killing 168 people including 19 children

1998: China released Wang Dan, one of the pro-democracy leaders imprisoned after the Tiananmen Square massacre
