▲ **2004:** The final *Oldsmobile* rolled off the General Motors' assembly line in Lansing, Michigan, 103 years after the first model made its debut

**1789:** Fletcher Christian and the crew of the *Bounty* staged a mutiny against Captain Bligh, who was cast adrift

**1945:** Italian dictator Benito Mussolini was executed by partisans

**1977:** Andreas Baader, leader of the Baader-Meinhoff terrorist group, was jailed for life in Germany

**2005:** Scientists confirmed sighting an ivory-billed woodpecker, a bird thought to have been extinct since 1944, in a wildlife refuge in Arkansas
