▲ 1904: Charles Rolls and Henry Royce signed an agreement to collaborate in the production of Rolls-Royce cars

**1493:** Pope Alexander VI, a Spaniard, decreed that all new lands discovered west of the Azores were Spanish

1926: The first General Strike in British history began

**1992:** Over 70,000 Thais protested at the appointment of unelected general Suchinda Kraprayoon as prime minister

2005: Paleontologists in Utah said they had discovered a new species of birdlike, feathered dinosaur that lived around 125 million years ago
