▲ 1937: Movie star Jean Harlow, the blonde bombshell of the 1930s, died from a cerebral oedema aged only 26

1523: Gustavus Vasa was proclaimed King Gustavus I of Sweden after he defeated the Danes

1906: The Cunard passenger liner Lusitania, sunk by a German U-boat in 1915, was launched

1929: The Papal State was revived for the first time since 1870 when the Vatican was established in Rome

2005: Former U.S. President Jimmy Carter called for the prison facility in Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, to be closed as controversy rose over its future
