

Indonesia soon to top bird flu death toll

Indonesia averaged one human bird flu fatality every two and a half days in May, putting it on course to overtake Vietnam as the world's hardest-hit nation. The two countries make up the bulk of the world's 127 total deaths since the virus began spreading in Asian poultry stocks in late 2003
