

Indonesian tsunami death toll passes 500

The tsunami which crashed into beach resorts and fishing villages on the island of Java is now known to have killed more than 500 people, with hundreds more missing or injured and thousands displaced

Dec 26, 2004: Magnitude 9.3 quake triggers massive tsunami killing nearly 300,000 around the Indian Ocean

July 17, Pangandaran: Magnitude 7.7 undersea quake strikes 240km offshore, causing 2m-high wave
