

■ **July 12:** Hezbollah guerrillas capture two Israeli soldiers and kill eight others. Israeli

Prime Minister **Ehud Olmert** calls it an “act of war” by Lebanon



■ **July 13:** Israeli aircraft bomb runways at Beirut airport and attack nearby Haret Hreik – stronghold of Hezbollah leader **Sheikh Hassan Nasrallah**. Israeli navy blockades Lebanese ports. 35 civilians killed in strikes on south Lebanon. Hezbollah retaliates by firing 60 rockets at Israeli city of Nahariya killing one civilian

■ **July 14:** Israel bombs main Beirut-Damascus highway, bridges, roads, power stations. **Lebanese body count rises to 60.** Hezbollah attacks Israeli missile ship with sophisticated Iranian-made **C-802** anti-ship missile – four sailors killed

## Lebanon crisis timeline

■ **July 15:** Lebanese Prime Minister **Fouad Siniora** demands ceasefire as death toll passes 100. Hezbollah rockets hit city of Tiberias

■ **July 16:** Hezbollah rockets kill eight civilians in Haifa, Israel's second city

■ **July 17:** Israeli F15 fighter destroys **Zelzal** missile which could reach Tel Aviv. Evacuation of foreigners gets under way

■ **July 18:** Israeli air strikes kill 11 Lebanese soldiers in their barracks near Beirut. Lebanese death toll passes 200. Hezbollah rockets again strike Haifa

■ **July 19:** Israel drops 23 tonnes of bombs on Beirut's Bourj al-Barajneh suburb in attempt to kill Nasrallah. Israeli commando units cross border – two Israeli soldiers killed, nine injured. One Israeli killed in rocket attack on Nahariya



■ **July 20:** Air attacks on southern Lebanese towns and Baalbek kill 45 civilians. Four Israeli soldiers killed near border. Hezbollah fires more than 120 rockets at Israel – two Israeli-Arab children killed in Nazareth

■ **July 21:** Israel calls up 3,000 reserves and drops leaflets over southern Lebanese villages warning civilians to leave area. Pro-Syrian Lebanese President **Emile Lahoud** warns that government troops will fight alongside Hezbollah if Israel invades his country



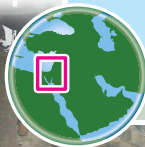
■ **July 22:** Israel ousts Hezbollah fighters from village of Maroun al-Ras after several days of fierce fighting. **U.S. rushes a delivery of GBU-28 laser-guided bunker-buster bombs to Israel**

■ **July 23:** Israel strikes Sidon – a city swelled with thousands of refugees. Hezbollah missiles land on Haifa killing 2 civilians. **United Nations humanitarian coordinator, Jan Egeland, accuses Israel of using “excessive force”**

■ **July 24:** Israeli troops and tanks cross into Lebanon and attack Hezbollah stronghold of Bint Jbail. **U.S. Secretary of State Condoleezza Rice arrives in Beirut at start of Middle East tour to seek ceasefire**
