

Civilians displaced by Lebanon war

Estimates vary as to the number of civilians forced from their homes but it could be as high as two million – while Israeli air and artillery strikes, and Hezbollah rockets continue to rain down

LEBANON 916,000 displaced including 550,000 staying with families, 130,000 in shelters

Beirut: 39,421 housed in schools, public institutions and camps. UNHCR preparing “tent city” for up to 350,000

Mount Lebanon (north): 28,122

Mount Lebanon (south): 12,646

ISRAEL 500,000 displaced

Rehoused mainly by private programmes in kibbutzim and family households

Around 2,700 rockets have struck northern Israel – most within 40km of border

Nitzanim: “Summer camp” housing 6,000 – paid for by Russian-Israeli billionaire **Arkady Gaidmak** at cost of \$500,000 per day
