
Expanded ground offensive put on hold

Up to 20,000 extra Israeli Defence Force (IDF) troops are set to join 10,000 others inside south Lebanon to establish a "buffer" zone and force Hezbollah fighters north of the Litani River. Hezbollah has fired more than 3,300 rockets at Israeli towns during the four-week-old offensive



1 Western sector:
Fierce fighting between IDF's Alexandroni
Infantry Brigade 903
and Hezbollah rocket squads dug-in between villages of Naqoura and Alma Shaab. Heavy fighting around Mansuri. Israeli gunboats shell coast north of Naqoura. Rocket attacks continue

2 Central sector:
Golani Brigade 1 and
Sa'ar Brigade 7
exchange intensive fire
around village of Bint
Jbeil – main Hezbollah
stronghold in south – and
Yarun. House-to-house
fighting between
Hezbollah units and
Paratroop Brigade 35
in Aita al-Shaab

3 Eastern sector:
Iron Tails 401 Armoured
Brigade enforced with
Nakhal Infantry Brigade
933 and Carmeli
Infantry Brigade 2 push
north, taking key town of
Marjayoun and village of
Blatt. IDF also advances
on Khiam from which
Hezbollah fires rockets
into northern Israel
