

Turkey bomb attacks

Multiple explosions in the Turkish cities of Marmaris, Antalya and Istanbul have killed three people and injured 45 others in 24 hours.

The Kurdistan Freedom Falcons (TAK) – a militant group with links to the banned PKK – has claimed responsibility for the blasts



Aug 28: Three people killed and 18 injured in tourist city of Antalya

Aug 27: Three bombs in Marmaris injure 21, including 10 British tourists. Six wounded in blast in Istanbul

Jun 25: Four killed, 25 injured in blast near restaurant in Antalya

Apr 16: Bomb attack in Bakirkoy district of Istanbul injures 31

Mar 31: Blast in Kocamustafapasa district of Istanbul kills 1, injures 16

Feb 9: One killed, 16 injured in blast at internet cafe in Istanbul
