Europe on top in recent years

The last 10 meetings of the biennial transatlantic showdown have swung Europe's way, with six match wins against three for the United States. Europe's nine-point win at Oakland Hills in 2004 was the largest margin of victory since 1981, when the Americans triumphed by the same score
