## Japan celebrates new royal prince


The birth of a son to Princess Kiko, wife of the Emperor's second son, Prince Akishino, has provided the first new heir to the Chrysanthemum throne in 41 years, easing a looming succession crisis for the centuries-old monarchy

660BC Accession of legendary Emperor Jimmu

5th century First historically verified emperor, Ojin, rules for 40 years

1763 Last reigning empress, *Gosakuramachi*, assumes throne

1889 Imperial House Law limits sitting monarchy to male descendants
