## **One-time password to boost online security**

Banks are turning to one-time password (OTP) technology in a bid to beat internet credit card fraud. Each time it is used the card's microchip generates a unique password which authenticates the card holder – replacing today's less reliable signature strip security number

## **AUTHENTICATION**

Current system is vulnerable if hacker obtains *security number* with card details. Information can be used to make purchases

## **OTP GENERATOR**

- 1 User presses card at **key enable point** to activate password generating microchip
- 2 Ultra-thin *e-paper display* can be used 16,000 times and has three-year battery life

## **SECOND MICROCHIP**

Personal information, details of last transaction or balance information stored on *smart-chip* – more secure than magnetic strip
