- **1492:** Columbus espied San Salvador in what was the first modern European sighting of the New World
- 1957: Britain's Jodrell Bank radio telescope, designed by Sir Bernard Lovell, went into operation
- **1963:** Legendary French chanteuse Edith Piaf died in Paris
- 1990: A crowd of 150,000 packed a stadium in Pyongyang to see North Korea beat South Korea 2-1 in the first soccer game between the divided nation on home soil
