▲ **2004:** Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan al-Nahyan, widely-admired president of the United Arab Emirates, died at age 86 following a long illness

**1721:** Peter I was proclaimed Emperor of all the Russias

**1920:** KDKA in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, became the world's first regular broadcasting station

**1990:** The parliament of Mozambique approved a new constitution making the country a multi-party democracy

**2003:** British adventurers Sir Ranulph Fiennes and Dr Michael Stroud completed seven marathons on seven continents in seven days
