▲ **1922:** Howard Carter found the first signs of the tomb of the boy pharaoh Tutankhamun in Egypt's Valley of the Kings

1854: Florence Nightingale arrived in the Crimea with 38 nurses to set up a hospital for British troops at Scutari

1952: Dwight D. Eisenhower was elected president of the United States

1984: Daniel Ortega became president of Nicaragua after an election victory by the Sandinista Front
