▲ 1860: Abraham Lincoln was elected president of the United States

1956: Construction of the Kariba High Dam began on the Zambesi River

1962: The UN General Assembly adopted a resolution condemning South Africa's apartheid policies and recommending economic sanctions

1975: Over 350,000 Moroccans crossed into Western Sahara as King Hassan launched the "Green March"

2005: The military government in Myanmar began moving all government ministries from the historic city of Yangon to a new capital at Pyinmana, 600km north
