1914: The British battleship *HMS Bulwark* blew up as it took ammunition on board, killing all but 12 of 750 crew

1922: American cartoonist Charles Schultz, creator of the *Peanuts* comic strip, was born

1966: The world's first tidal power station was opened in France at the Rance estuary in Brittany

2001: A U.S. firm claimed to have cloned the first human embryo for use in medical research
