Chavez UN seat bid

Venezuela's Hugo Chavez has lobbied for a UN Security Council seat by spreading \$1.1 billion in donations, loans and financial aid around the world in a bid to influence the General Assembly



- Security Council: 15 seats, five permanent members with veto power United States, Russia, China, Britain and France and 10 nations serving for two-year terms, five of them elected each year
- Vote required: Two-thirds of 192-member General Assembly
- Seats available: Argentina, Japan, Denmark, Greece and Tanzania
- Held until end 2007: Peru, Qatar, Congo Rep., Ghana and Slovenia
