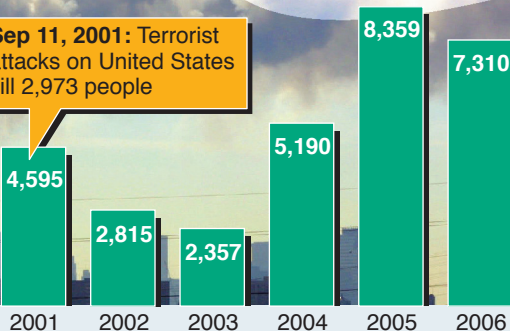


Five years of warfare claim 80,000 lives

The Bush administration's *War on Terror* – precipitated by the devastating 9/11 attacks on America – has led to five years of constant warfare. Since 2001 over 18,000 terrorist attacks, U.S.-led invasions of Afghanistan and Iraq, and the Israel-Lebanon conflict have claimed more than 80,000 lives

Deaths caused by terrorism
Jan 2001-Sep 2006: 30,626

Sep 11, 2001: Terrorist attacks on United States kill 2,973 people

United States: **2,990**

Includes 9/11 victims, anthrax attacks (5 deaths), Egyptian gunman in Los Angeles (2), and sniper attacks by al-Qaeda admirer around Washington DC (10)
