

Rebel threat to Nigeria's oil industry

Attacks by separatist militants seeking local control of Nigeria's oil resources in the Niger Delta are cutting almost 10 percent of Nigeria's exports. More than 45 foreign workers have been kidnapped this year and some 30 Nigerian workers have been killed
