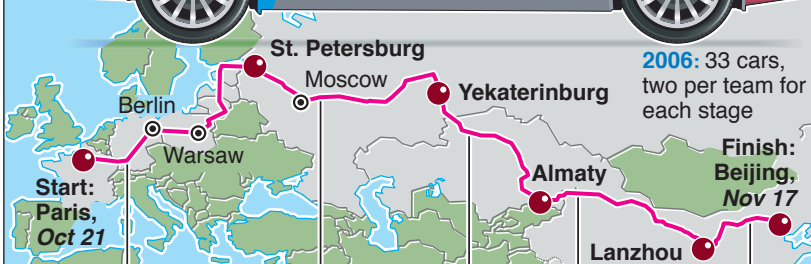


Mercedes tackles Paris to Beijing in 26 days

Almost a century after the first transcontinental motor race from Beijing to Paris, Mercedes aims to test the potential of its new generation E-Class by making the trip in reverse. The 13,600km race will be less a test of speed than a challenge to achieve the lowest possible fuel consumption

2: 2,700km

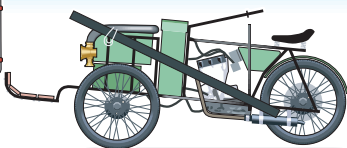
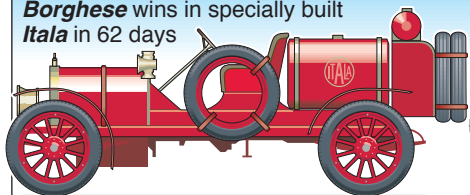

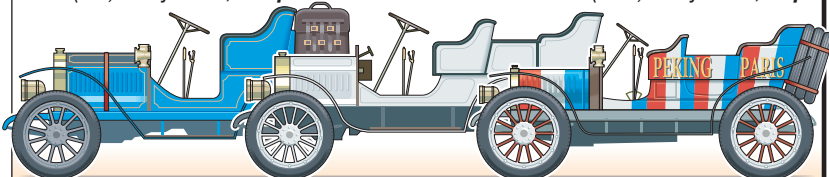
1907: Italian aristocrat **Prince Scipione Borghese** wins in specially built **Itala** in 62 days
