

Hariri tribunal could include Gemayal case

With the Lebanese Cabinet still to approve an international tribunal to try the Feb 2005 murder of former Premier Rafik Hariri, UN investigators are set to probe 15 other attacks on anti-Syrians including the slain Industry Minister Pierre Gemayal. Syria has refused to cooperate with the Tribunal
