

Indonesian disasters timeline

Dec 26, 2004: Magnitude 9.0 quake triggers massive tsunami, killing more than 126,000 people in Indonesia, mostly in Aceh province on Sumatra island

Dec 23, 2006: Heavy rains unleash floods that kill more than 100 and displace over 400,000 in Aceh Tamiang

Sep 4, 2005, Medan: Indonesian jet crashes into residential neighbourhood of city, killing at least 149 people

Jan 1, 2007, Sulawesi: At least 90 people killed when plane crashes in stormy weather during flight from Java to Manado

Dec 29, 2006: Ferry sinks killing 400

Mar 28, 2005
8.7 magnitude quake kills 900 people and leaves tens of thousands homeless

Jul 17, 2006: Magnitude 7.7 undersea quake causes tsunami which kills at least 668 people and leaves 65 others missing

May 2006: Mud flows displace more than 10,000 people

May 27, 2006: 6.3 magnitude quake kills more than 5,800 people
