proposal to send 21,500 additional troops to Iraq



War on Terror: Boost size of Army and Marine Corps by 65,000 soldiers and 27,000 Marines over next five years



Energy: Slash petrol consumption by 20% in 10 years by improving vehicle fuel standards and increasing use of

alternative fuels such as ethanol. Step up domestic oil production



Reforms: Help 47m Americans obtain health insurance with tax breaks of \$15,000 for families and \$7,500 for

individuals. Immigration reform to provide guest worker programme for foreign workers
