U.S. to rank pandemics like hurricanes

The U.S. government will predict the severity of the next flu pandemic just like forecasters predict hurricane strength – using a ranking system to help communities determine when they should take increasingly strong steps to combat the spread of flu Projected Deaths*

Category 1: Recommend voluntary isolation and treatment of ill persons

Category 2-3: Recommend household members of ill persons to stay at home

Consider dismissal of students from schools and closing child care programmes for up to one month, and reducing contact among children and teens in community

Consider social distancing of adults at work and in community, including closing large public gatherings, and changing workplace environments and work schedules – without disrupting essential services

Category 4-5: Recommend all of above. School

closures and child social distancing measures extended for up to three months
