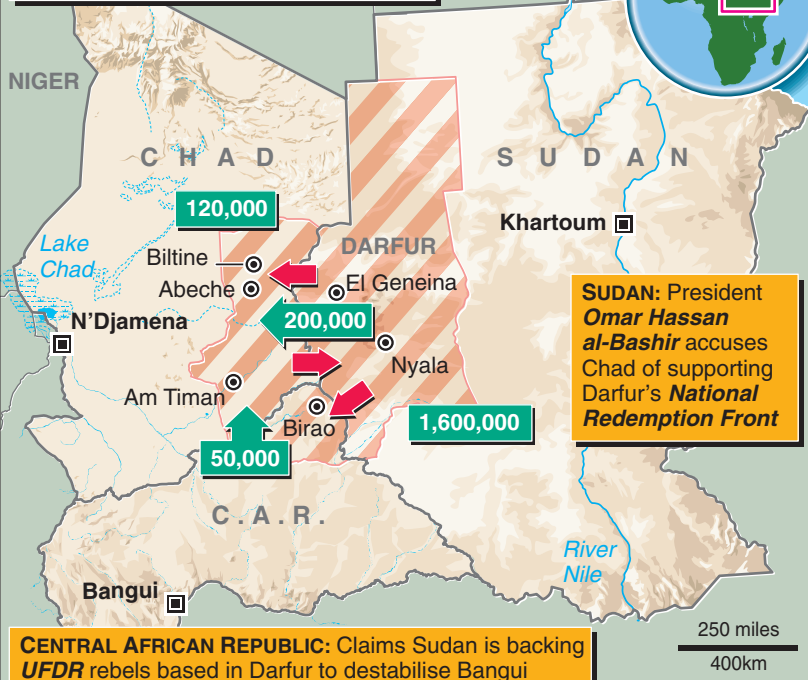


Darfur genocide spreading to Chad

Despite pledges by the leaders of Sudan, Chad and the Central African Republic not to support rebels threatening each others' regimes, the ethnic conflict in Darfur now threatens to engulf the entire region. Sudan has continued to refuse the deployment of UN peacekeepers
