

# UN to impose new sanctions on Iran

The Security Council is set to vote on a new draft resolution to tighten UN sanctions against Iran over its nuclear defiance. The text follows on from a December 2006 resolution that imposed trade sanctions on Iran's sensitive nuclear materials and froze assets of individuals and companies



Extends assets freeze to companies and individuals supporting sensitive nuclear activities, including state-owned **Bank Sepah** and firms owned by Iran's **Revolutionary Guards Corp**



Imposes embargo on conventional weapons Iran can export but calls on states to "exercise vigilance and restraint" in shipping any heavy weapons to Iran



Orders nations to notify UN panel if Iranian officials engaged in sensitive nuclear activities enter their territories. Expands list of people included in Dec. resolution



Calls on nations and international financial institutions not to enter into new commitments for financial assistance to Iran except for humanitarian purposes

**Draft asks IAEA to report within 60 days whether Iran has complied. If not, further action will be considered**
