

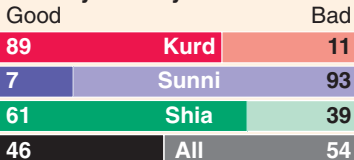
Poll shows Iraqis pessimistic for future

Four years after the U.S.-led invasion, Iraqis face widespread violence, collapsing services and stark sectarian divisions. More than half of all Iraqis have had a close friend or relative injured or killed, and fears for their safety has left around 70% showing signs of traumatic stress

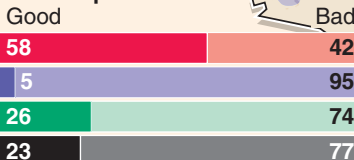
What is the single biggest problem you face in your life?

How would you rate the availability of jobs?



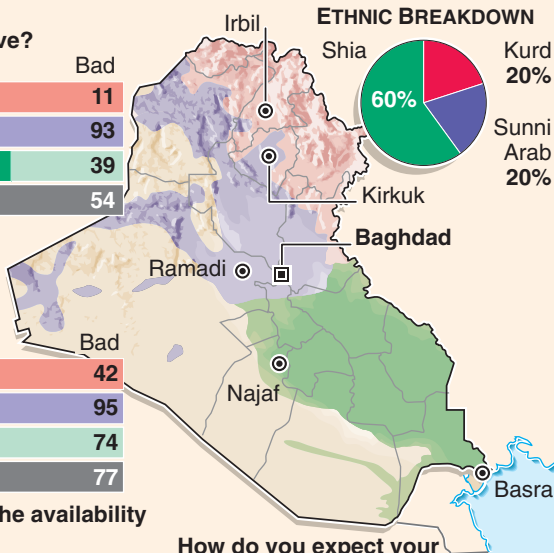
