At least 157 people have been killed in four attacks in Iraq's capital, Baghdad, despite an ongoing U.S.-led security crackdown



- 1 Apr 18, 2007, Sadr City: Car bomb kills 30 Shias at checkpoint
- 2 Sadriya: Car bomb kills at least 116 at market in Shia-dominated area
- 3 Al-Shurja: Minibus bomb kills two
- 4 Karrada: Car bomb near private hospital kills at least 10
- Feb 3, Sadriya: 130 killed in lorry bomb attack in market
- Dec 2, 2006, Sadriya: More than 50 killed by multiple car bombs
- Nov 23, Sadr City: At least 200 killed in wave of car bombings
- Apr 7: Triple suicide bombing at Shia Buratha Mosque kills 85 people
