

Iraq civilian deaths

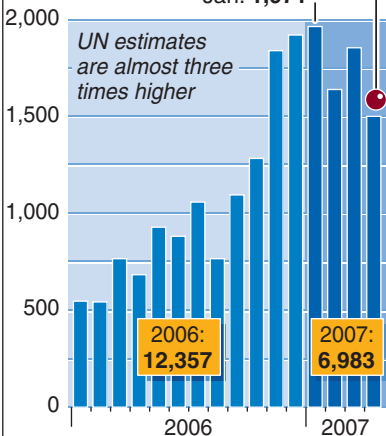
Civilian deaths fell by a fifth in April, according to data compiled by the Iraq interior, defence and health ministries. However, April was a bad month for coalition forces, with 104 U.S. and 12 British soldiers killed, making it one of the deadliest months of the war
