- ► Faction split in 2006 from Syrian-backed Palestinian group Fatah al-Intifada, itself a breakaway from Yasser Arafat's Fatah Movement
- ▶ Based in *Nahr al-Bared*Palestinian refugee camp –
 has over 200 fighters

► Allegedly linked to Syrian intelligence

- Lebanese government claims four Syrian members
- of Fatah al-Islam confessed to February bus bombings which killed three people in Christian area near Beirut
