■ **July 25, 1953:** Born Evergreen Park, Illinois

■ **Education:** Degrees from Swarthmore College, 1975; Harvard University, 1981

■ **1983-85:** CEO, Fannie Mae

■ **Government service, 1985-1993:** U.S. Treasury Department, Under secretary of state, Deputy chief of staff to President George H.W. Bush

■ **Business, academia, 1993-2001:** Fannie Mae, U.S. Naval Academy, Centre for Strategic & International Studies, German Marshall Fund

■ **2001-present:** Appointed U.S. Trade Representative then Deputy Secretary of State by President Bush. Joined Goldman Sachs in 2006
